


Visitor Advisory

As Shuttle Ground Operations personnel, you are asked to ignore all signs indicating "Shuttle Viewing Area" along major highways and continue on the route indicated on the map. Your points of entry will be the west (Rosamond) or north (Route 58) gates. They will be closed to general public traffic. There will be civil and military authorities at selected points to assist you in finding your appropriate area. Please use the map to minimize delays to your area.

Conditions of Visit

- * Observe traffic laws.
- * Display vehicle pass on inside left corner of windshield at all times while on base.
- * Person issued pass is responsible for others in party and will keep pass readily available to show proof of authorized visit by all.
- * Limit your movements to authorized areas and traffic ways. (AUTHORIZED AREA NASA Ames-Dryden complex). Examples of signed closed areas are "RESTRICTED AREA" or "CONTROLLED AREA".
